COUNTIES Evangelists: Your Questions Answered:

- **Are COUNTIES Evangelists employed by them?**
No! Evangelists receive no salary from COUNTIES and are all self-employed.
- **What financial support is provided by COUNTIES?**
Depending on funds available, COUNTIES provides a variable gift each month, but this equates to just a proportion of an Evangelist's actual living costs.
- **Who provides the rest of their income?**
The short answer is, 'God does!' Each Evangelist trusts God to provide for their needs. In practice, this means that God does this through His people – like you and me who value the work that is being done. Donations made to an Evangelist do not affect their usual COUNTIES gift. In addition UK tax-payers gifts can be increased with Gift-Aid.
- **Do COUNTIES Evangelists make a charge for their services?**
No, not usually. Most Evangelists work on the basis of an invitation, and rely on churches (or other groups they work with) to acknowledge their work, preparation and general expenses.
- **What about non-Church activities?**
Occasionally, a school may pay the Evangelists some travelling expenses. Some Churches have 'adopted' a school in their area and agreed to 'sponsor' school assemblies or lessons.
- **Are some Evangelists working for one local church?**
COUNTIES recognises the value of Evangelists being based in one church and their funding from COUNTIES is unaffected while this occupies under 50% of their time.
- **What Biblical principles are being followed?**
*"In the same way, the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel." (1 Cor. 9:14)
