## Notes concerning Gift Aid

- All Gift Aid donations must be supported by a valid '**Gift Aid declaration**'. Please complete the form as **fully as possible** and do not add any additional notes or explanations.
- **Tax claimed:** Counties can reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give after 5 April 2008.
- HM Revenue & Customs will not allow Gift Aid to be claimed on a gift where the donor **requires** that the charity use funds in a certain way. Please read the consequent wording that follows before signing the form, as a signature will be taken as acceptance of the conditions under which Gift Aid tax is reclaimed.  
*Where a donation is given with an **expressed wish** for the allocation of the funds the Trustees will consider the donors wishes in the light of the objectives of the charity.*
- Special rules apply to donations made by **connected persons** (including lineal descendants, 'in-laws' and business partners).
- If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate, if you want to receive the additional **tax relief due**, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return.
- Please notify us of any **changes in circumstances** e.g. changes of name or address, if you wish to cancel this declaration, or if you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.
