### Notes concerning Gift Aid

Signing this declaration will be taken as acceptance of the conditions under which Gift Aid is reclaimed.

- All Gift Aid donations must be supported by a valid **Gift Aid declaration**. Please complete the form as **fully as possible** and do not add any additional notes or explanations.
- **Tax claimed:** Counties can currently reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give, for the **four years** prior to this year and all future donations.
- Please notify us of any **changes of name or address**, if you wish to **cancel** this declaration, or if you **no longer pay sufficient tax** on your income and/or capital gains.
- When the Counties Trustees invite an individual to join as an **Evangelist**, in effect a restricted fund is created for the evangelist and their activities that further the purposes of the charity. Trustees invite donations to these restricted funds. Where a donation is given with an expressed wish for funds to be allocated to an evangelist, these funds will be passed on, normally together with the regular monthly gifts.
- Please let us know if you wish any donation to remain **anonymous**.
- Gift Aid cannot be applied on donations made by **connected persons** including
  - a brother/sister, mother/father, son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, grandmother/grandfather
  - a wife, husband or civil partner, or the wife/husband/civil partner of any of the above
  - business partners.
- If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the **additional tax relief** due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
