- All Gift Aid donations must be supported by a valid **Gift Aid declaration**. Please complete the form as **fully as possible** and do not add any additional notes or explanations.
- **Tax claimed:** Counties can currently reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give, for the **four years** prior to this year and all future donations.
- HM Revenue & Customs will not allow Gift Aid to be claimed where a donor requires a charity to use funds in a certain way. Where a donation is given with an **expressed wish** for the allocation of the funds the Trustees will consider the donors wishes in the light of the objectives of the charity.
- Please let us know if you wish any donation to remain **anonymous**.
- Special rules apply to donations made by **connected persons** including
 - a brother/sister, mother/father, son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, grandmother/grandfather
 - a wife, husband or civil partner, or the wife/husband/civil partner of any of the above
 - business partners.
- Please notify us of any **changes of name** or **address**, if you wish to **cancel** this declaration, or if you **no longer pay sufficient tax** on your income and/or capital gains.
- If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the **additional tax relief** due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
